It's Senior Farmers' Market Voucher Time!



What is the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program?

Eligible seniors receive vouchers worth \$45 to purchase locally grown produce at approved farmers' markets and roadside stands.

Who is Eligible?

- Rock County residents age 60 or older (Native Americans 55 or older)
- Monthly <u>household</u> income which is not more than \$2,322 for one person or \$3,152 for two people, etc. (see next page for Income Eligibility Table)

<u>How Do I Get These Vouchers</u>? Vouchers will be distributed at multiple locations (see below). There are a limited number of vouchers available; distributions are on a first come, first served basis.

How Can I Get Vouchers If I Can't Get to a Distribution?

Two options:

- 1) If you are unable to get to a distribution and would like someone else to pick up vouchers for you, you must call the ADRC Nutrition Program (608-757-5428) at least one week in advance of the distribution to request a Proxy Authorization Form. This is the only document which will permit someone else to receive vouchers on behalf of an eligible senior. The form must be signed by the voucher recipient, then taken by the authorized representative to a distribution. Limit of 4 proxy forms per representative. If distributions have already been completed, call 608-757-5428 for voucher availability and options.
- 2) Beginning July 2, any remaining vouchers will be distributed on a first come first served basis. Call 608-757-5428 for availability and options; leave a voicemail.
