There are currently 3 adults: Ash, Camron, and Malcom in the program, and it is looking for opportunities to increase participation. The program is for adults 18-21 years old transitioning into the community and working to build work/life skills. Ash, Camron, and Malcolm taxi to ECO Monday-Thursday volunteering for two hours in different areas. 2 of them walk home and 1 is picked up at the end of their day. They are supported by 2 Edgerton School District staff daily, Michelle and Liz. The Edgerton School District staff like "watching the progress towards increased independence and "seeing enthusiasm of the "guys" to volunteer each day."

When asked what they like about Outreach, Malcom stated he likes "helping the community" and Camron shared he likes "helping and enjoys working with volunteers and staff."
