ECO Note/Community News

Over 60 walkers and 15 volunteers took to the snowy streets on Saturday night, February 28th to raise money for ECO's fundraiser called The Coldest Night of The Year. The walk is a short experience in the cold recognizing that others have to find a way to survive in the cold amongst finding a way to meet other basic needs. Here's why we did it. Last year ECO provided 18, 523 snack packs for kids, 708 supplements of food for kids to take home on the weekends during the school year, and 1, 965 meals for kids at Central Park in the summer. Lastly, we provided 727 shelter nights for households without a place to stay of their own. These are eye-opening numbers for a small town as ECO continues to envision a "community where we are all welcomed, fed, clothed, and have a warm place to call home."
