Volunteer Highlight

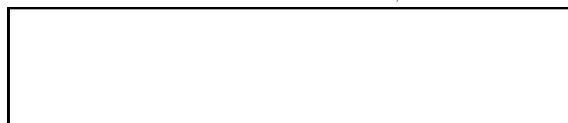
Barb has been volunteering at ECO since around 2021.
