

## What is the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program?

**FREE to eligible seniors:** Vouchers worth \$25 to purchase locally grown produce at approved farmers' markets and roadside stands.



## Who is Eligible?

- Rock County residents age 60 or older (Native Americans 55 or older)
- Monthly household income not more than \$2,461 for one person or \$3,337 for two people, etc. (see next page for *Income Eligibility Table*)
- Though based on household income, each qualifying individual may receive vouchers once in 2026.

**Qualifying seniors are strongly encouraged to attend one of the distributions listed below, as the number of available vouchers is significantly reduced from last year. Once listed distributions have been completed, if any vouchers remain, there will be no further opportunity to get them until mid-July. Check Rock County ADRC website for updates.**

## What if I Can't Get to a Distribution?

- 1) Do you need someone else to pick up vouchers for you at a distribution? You must call at least one week in advance (608) 757-5428 to request a Proxy Authorization Form. The form must be signed by the voucher recipient, then **taken by the proxy** (authorized representative) to a distribution. This is the only document which will permit someone else to receive vouchers on behalf of an eligible senior. Limit of 4 proxy forms per representative.
- 2) Beginning July 15, if any vouchers remain, they will be available at the ADRC from 9am – 3pm, while supplies last. **Check Rock County ADRC website or call 608-757-5428 in advance.**
